IMPORTANT GUIDING RULES FOR THE ATTENTION OF CANDIDATES

1. The applicants should read the Information Bulletin carefully before filling up the Application Form.
2. Information about various Universities and Institutions is compiled based on the information provided by the respective University and Institute. For further information and clarifications, the candidate is advised to contact the respective University/Institute.
3. It may clearly be noted that the GCET Committee allots seats to the candidates who have qualified in the GCET 2008 based on their merit position, but the final admission will be confirmed only by the concerned university by issuing the eligibility certificate to the candidate. The GCET Committee will not be responsible if any university does not issue the eligibility certificate to a particular candidate for any reason whatsoever.
4. The medium of instruction for MCA in all the Universities of the State is English.
5. Any change or modification of the rules/guidelines/instructions given in this bulletin and Government Resolution and / or Government Act relating to GCET-2008 shall be binding on all concerned.
6. The final eligibility will be checked/decided at the time of allotment of seats by GCET committee and at the time of giving admission by the respective Institute/University. The acceptance of the Application Form or appearance in the Entrance Test does not confirm eligibility of the candidate.
7. At the time of counselling and allotment of seats, the candidates are required to bring all the relevant original documents and the required fees in Banker's Cheque/DD. The candidate will also have to deposit the original documents with the GCET Committee, if the allotted seat is accepted. The candidates, therefore, should keep sufficient number of attested copies of these documents for their use for other purposes, as the original documents deposited will be returned only after about six months through the institute where the admission is taken and the same cannot be returned to any candidate in the interim period for any other purpose.
8. In case of any dispute arising out of the interpretation of any provision of the Government Resolution governing the GCET 2008, the final decision in all such cases shall be of the Education Department, Government of Gujarat.
9. In case of need, the Chairman, GCET 2008, may add to or modify the rules/guidelines governing the admission process given in the Information Bulletin, which will be binding on all concerned.
10. As the allotment of students to different institutes will be made strictly on the basis of merit, seats available and the choice of the candidate, there will be no mutual exchange of students/transfer of students between different institutes after the final reshuffling-round and during the entire course of study as such an exercise will result in distortions of merit and nullify the entire purpose of centralised admission.
11. **In case, due to unavoidable/unforeseen circumstances, if it becomes necessary to make any change in the above schedule, the same will be notified on the GCET-2008 link of the website www.spuvvn.edu and on the notice boards of nodal centres. The candidates, therefore, are requested to see the website/notice boards of the nodal centres periodically.**
12. Any dispute arising out the GCET-2008 admission process shall be within the jurisdiction of the courts in Anand.

GUJARAT COMMON ENTRANCE TEST (GCET) – 2008:

This is the seventh year since the inception of the Gujarat Common Entrance Test (GCET) for MCA. There are national level entrance tests such as CAT, MAT, XAT etc. However, GCET at the state level has found a firm footing and provided a single platform to the MCA aspirant students. The Education Department, Government of Gujarat, vide Notification No. GH/SH/13/2008/PVS/102008-1465-S dated May 29, 2008, has decided that the Gujarat Common Entrance Test for the MCA programmes of all Universities of Gujarat State for the academic year 2008-09 will be conducted by Sardar Patel University. As per the Notification No. GH/SH/10/2008/MBA/102008-633-S dated May 23, 2008, admission to all seats in government colleges or institutions and in the aided colleges or institutions and also the seventy five percent of the total sanctioned seats in the unaided colleges or institutions will be given by the GCET Admission Committee. If private unaided institutions surrender their sanctioned seats, then such seats will also be filled by the GCET Committee.

2 NODAL AGENCY – SARDAR PATEL UNIVERSITY:

The Sardar Patel University, situated in the educational township of Vallabh Vidyanagar can truly be described as a living monument to the memory of the Iron Man of India, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. The lush green University campus, with well laid out beautiful trees has a healthy, natural and peaceful environment amply conducive for educational pursuits.

Vallabh Vidyanagar is a unique educational township. The development and construction of the University has taken place in accordance with a well-integrated master plan. The university has 61 affiliated colleges catering to various disciplines apart from 25 Post Graduate Departments in Business Administration, Sciences, Social Sciences, and Humanities. In addition, there are separate hostels for female and male students, a Health Centre, a Central Library, a guesthouse, staff quarters, a botanical garden and playground.

Sardar Patel University was among the first in Gujarat and Rajasthan to volunteer for assessment and accreditation by the **NAAC** (National Assessment and Accreditation Council), Bangalore. The University was awarded a **Four Star Rating** in January 2001.

3 GCET-2008 ADMISSION COMMITTEE:

The Gujarat Common Entrance Test (GCET), 2008 will be conducted under the direction of a committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellors of the Universities in accordance with the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi guidelines. The Director of Technical Education, Gujarat State is the Chairman of this Committee.

The Sardar Patel University has been entrusted with the task of conducting the entrance test for the academic year 2008-09. The Admission Committee has been formed with Shri Bharatbhai Patel, Vice-Chancellor, Sardar Patel University as its Chairman. The address of the Admission Committee is:

4 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 4.1 For the purpose of admission, a candidate shall have appeared in the Gujarat Common Entrance Test (GCET).
- 4.2 To appear in the Gujarat Common Entrance Test (GCET), a candidate shall have passed the qualifying examination from:
- (a) a University situated in the Gujarat State; or
 - (b) a University situated out side the Gujarat State provided the candidate shall have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (Standard XII, 10+2 pattern) or its equivalent examination from,-
 - (i) the Gujarat Board; or
 - (ii) the Central Board of Secondary Education Board provided that the school in which the candidate has studied, should have been located in the State of Gujarat; or
 - (iii) the Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi Board provided that the school in which candidate has studied should have been located in State of Gujarat.

Provided that a candidate shall have passed the Higher Secondary School Examination (Standard XII, 10+2 pattern) or Bachelors' degree with Mathematics or Business Mathematics or Statistics as one of the subjects.

- 4.3 A candidate who has appeared in final year of Bachelor's Degree examination shall also be eligible to appear in the Gujarat Common Entrance Test (GCET) provided that he shall have passed the qualifying examination at the time of admission.
- 4.4 The candidates must have passed graduation in any discipline, including BCA course from a university located in the State of Gujarat.
- 4.5 A candidate who has appeared at the final year (Bachelor's Degree) examination of any university recognised by the Association of Indian Universities (subject to conditions 4.1 to 4.4) shall be treated as provisionally eligible for GCET.
- 4.6 For wards of Kashmiri migrants, one supernumerary seat will be allotted in each institution where the seats are filled by the GCET Committee, based on a separate merit list prepared for the purpose. In their case, the eligibility conditions mentioned at 4.2 will not be applicable.

5 ALLOCATION OF SEATS:

- 5.1 Admissions to all seats in Government, Grant-in-aid Institutions and Institutions run by universities will be given by the GCET-2008 Committee.
- 5.2 In addition, seventy five percent of the total sanctioned seats in the unaided colleges or institutions will also be given by the GCET-2008 Committee.
- 5.3 If Private Unaided Institutes surrender their 25 % management seats either fully or partially to GCET-2008 Committee, then such seats will also be filled by the Committee.
- 5.4 The management seats may be filled by the management of the respective unaided colleges or institutions based on the *inter-se* merit list of the students whose names appear in the merit list prepared by the Admission Committee.

Note: No admission will be given to any MCA programmes in any of the University of Gujarat State without GCET.

6 PARTICIPATING INSTITUTES:

The position of university and institute which is participating in GCET-2008 for their MCA programme is given. The short profiles of all participating universities and institutes are given in this bulletin. The institutional profile is based on the information supplied by the respective Institute/University. The respective University/Institute is responsible for the correctness and the validity of the information provided to the GCET Committee. For further information and clarifications, the candidate is advised to contact the respective University/Institute.

In the given table, GIA denotes "grant in aid or government institute" and SFI denotes "self-financing Institute/programme" (Private Unaided Institute/Programmes). Each Institute is identified by a short code: the first three letters of which denote the name of the institute, the next two letters denote the location of the institute and the next two letters denote the name of the university to which the institute is affiliated. The final 'G' or 'S' indicates whether the programme/institute is grant-in-aid or self-financing.

If additional Institutes are approved and/or additional intake capacity of students is notified ,then they will be duly included before the commencement of the first counselling and final allocation of seats and any seats increase after that will be filled in the next year.

7 RESERVATION OF SEATS:

7.1 For the purpose of admission, the seats shall be reserved for the candidates who are origin of Gujarat and falling under the following categories, namely:

7.2 A candidate seeking admission on reserved seat shall be required to produce a Certificate of caste from which he originates:

Provided that the candidate belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Class shall be required to produce a certificate to the effect of non-inclusion in Creamy Layer in addition to the caste certificate.

7.3 No caste certificate shall be valid unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat.

- 7.4 No certificate to the effect of non-inclusion in Creamy Layer shall be valid, unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat. Such certificate shall have been issued on or after the 1st April of the academic year in which the candidate is seeking admission.
- 7.5 If a candidate fails to submit the certificate as required under sub-rule (2) within the stipulated time, his candidature shall be considered for admission under unreserved category.
- 7.6 If a candidate of reserved category gets admission on unreserved seat in order of merits, he may be given admission on the unreserved seat according to his preference.
- 7.7 The admission of a student of a reserved category on a reserved seat shall be valid subject to the verification of caste certificate by the authority empowered by the State Government in this behalf. In case the caste certificate is found invalid on verification, he shall not have right to claim his admission on reserved seat and if he has been already granted admission, such admission shall be cancelled.
- 7.8 After granting admission to all the students of reserved categories on reserved seats, the reserved category seats remaining vacant shall be transferred to the unreserved category seats.

8 RESERVATION FOR PHYSICALLY DISABLED CANDIDATES:

Three percent of the available seats in each category shall be reserved, in accordance with the provisions of the Persons With Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (I of 1996), for the person with disability who can perform the academic activities in the respective course. A candidate with disability shall have to submit certificate of disability issued and duly signed by the Civil Surgeon.

Explanation:- “person with disability” means a person suffering from not less than forty per cent of any disability as certified by medical authority.

9 RESERVATION FOR THE CHILDREN OF DEFENCE PERSONALS AND EX-SERVICEMEN:

- 9.1 One percent of available seats shall be reserved for the children of Defence personals and Ex-Servicemen, for admission.
- 9.2 A candidate claiming admission against Ex-Servicemen category shall be required to submit a certificate to that effect duly issued by the Director, Sainik Welfare Board, Gujarat State or by the District Sainik Welfare Officer. In-Service Defence Personnel shall be required to submit certificate to that effect duly issued by the Commanding Officer of the respective unit in which they are serving.
- 9.3 The seats remaining vacant against the category of Defence Personals and Ex-Servicemen in case of candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board, shall be allotted to the children of defence personals and Ex-Servicemen of the Central Board. The seats remaining vacant thereafter shall be filled up from the merit list of unreserved category candidates of the Gujarat Board.
- 9.4 The children of Defence Personals and Ex-Servicemen of Gujarat origin shall be included under the reserved category specified in this rule, if they have passed the qualifying examination from the schools located outside the Gujarat State and have appeared in the Gujarat Common Entrance Test conducted in the current academic year.

Note: Candidate applying against reserved quota should make sure about their eligibility to apply against the particular quota, as per the Government of Gujarat rules. At the time of counselling and allotment of seats, the original documents of the candidate relating to eligibility for reservation will be scrutinized by an official from the concerned department of the State Government and his/her decision regarding the candidate's eligibility for reservation against the particular category will be final. The acceptance of their application forms and their participation in the entrance test do not automatically make them eligible for allotment of seats against the category they have specified. The candidature of such candidates is liable to be cancelled from that category at any point of detection of their ineligibility. The applicants' data, including the category, will be displayed at the concerned test centres and also in the Sardar Patel University website and any mistakes or discrepancies should be brought to the notice of the Nodal Officer of the concerned university or the GCET Committee at the Sardar Patel University for making the necessary changes. **NO CANDIDATE WILL BE ALLOWED TO CHANGE HIS/HER CATEGORY AFTER THE MERIT LISTS ARE ANNOUNCED.**

10 SELECTION PROCESS:

The Selection process consists of an Entrance Test. Based on the marks scored in the Entrance Test merit lists will be prepared.

The logic for removing ties in the scores will be as under

1. Higher marks (Grand total) in XIIth Std.
2. Higher marks (Grand total) in Xth Std.
3. Graduation percentage based on the Grand Total of the final year mark-sheet shown by the concerned university.
4. If tie continuous, then the decision of the chairman of the GCET-2008 Admission Committee shall be final.

11 ENTRANCE TEST:

11.1 The Entrance Test will be conducted at the following centres:

Ahmedabad, Bhavnagar, Bhuj, Gandhinagar, Kherva, Patan, Rajkot, Surat, Vadodara, Vallabh Vidyanagar.

11.2 The entrance test will be in English only.

11.3 The duration of the test will be three hours.

11.4 There will be 250 questions of objective nature, with each question having four alternative answers.

11.5 There will be negative marking of 25% of the marks allotted to the question for wrong answer.

11.6 The aspects to be covered will be: Quantitative Ability; Analytical and Logical Reasoning; language Ability; Mathematics/Business Mathematics/Statistics up to 12 standard of Gujarat HSC Board level.

12 FEE STRUCTURE:

12.1 The candidate who gets admission shall, at the time of admission, pay such fee as may be determined by the Fee Regulation Committee of the State Government.

12.2 In case the candidate who having paid the fees after getting admission gets his admission cancelled, provided that the seat vacated by him is filled by another

candidate, shall be paid back the fees paid by him after the completion of admission process.

- 12.3 In case the candidate who having paid the fees after getting admission and gets his admission changed in another college or Institution in the readjustment (reshuffling) process, the difference of fees, if any, shall be payable by the student at the time of getting admission in the readjustment (reshuffling), or as the case may be, shall be refunded to him after the completion of admission process.

13 ADMISSION PROCESS:

14.1 Price of Information Bulletin –cum-Application Form

The candidates can purchase the information Bulletin –Cum-Application Form from any of the nodal centres listed in the advertisement on payment of Rs.650/- in cash. No request for sending the information Bulletin –cum-Application Form through post or courier will be entertained.

14.2 Submission of Application Forms :

- (a) The duly completed Application form can be submitted at any of the following centres where the **candidate intends to appear for the entrance test**. - (b) The candidates are required to submit their Application forms complete **in all respects in person only. Application forms received through post or courier will not be entertained.**
- (c) At the time of submission of the application form, the form will be checked by the centre staff and if prima facie found in order; the candidate will be allotted a seat number.

- (d) The candidates whose application forms are accepted will also be issued two Admit Cards: one for the Entrance Test and the other for Counselling, after entering the seat number therein. The candidates should ensure that they have collected both the above admit cards before leaving the counter after submission of the application forms. These admit cards should be carefully preserved and carried by the candidates at the time of the entrance test and Counselling.

14.3 Candidate data

The details of the applicants, including their seat numbers, test centre, venue, category, etc. will be displayed on the date specified in Important Date Schedule earlier, on the Sardar Patel University website www.spuvvn.edu and at the respective University Nodal Centre which the applicants have chosen to appear for the Entrance Test. Candidates should verify the correctness of their details displayed and discrepancy, if any, should be brought to the notice of the respective University centre for rectification latest by the date specified in Important Date Schedule mentioned earlier. No request received thereafter will be entertained.

14.4 Entrance Test:

The entrance test for MCA will be conducted between 12.00 noon and 3.00 pm. at the notified centres/venues on the date as per the advertisement and as per the Important Date Schedule mentioned earlier in the Information Bulletin.

14.5 Final Merit Lists and Counselling Schedule:

The final merit lists will show the category-wise rank and the general (combined) rank of each candidate. The merit lists and the schedule for Counselling will be displayed on the Sardar Patel University website www.spuvvn.edu and at all the Nodal Centres on the date specified in Important Date Schedule mentioned earlier. The schedule for Counselling will also be notified through news papers and will also be available at the University Nodal Centres.

No request for rechecking/reassessment of the entrance test scores or the ranks notified in the merit lists will be entertained.

15 COMMUNICATION WITH THE CANDIDATES :

No personal/postal communication will be made in regard to Entrance Test, Counselling and related activities. All the required information will be available on the Sardar Patel University website from time to time. Candidates can also approach the GCET Committee, Sardar University **on helpline No. 02692-229437**. All the relevant information will also be available from the ten nodal centres where entrance tests will be conducted.

Candidates are also advised to mention their Mobile Phone Numbers(one only) in the application form. GCET Committee may try to provide results (Rank etc.) to the candidates whose mobile phone numbers are available with GCET through SMS.

16 RULES FOR ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

- 16.1 The counselling and allotment of seats will be done by GCET-2008 Admission Committee, Sardar Patel University at the following address on the basis of merit list prepared for the respective categories :

- 16.2 The candidate whose name appears in the merit list shall have to remain present personally for counselling for the purpose of admission at the scheduled date, time and place alongwith the requisite documents and fee (mentioned later).
- 16.3 In case the candidate is unable to remain present personally, on the date, time and place of counselling, due to serious illness, accident or unavoidable circumstances, his parents or guardian shall, after obtaining prior approval of the Committee or any officer authorized by the Committee, remain present on the scheduled date, time and place. An authority letter signed by the candidate showing his order of preference and choice of college or institutions shall have to be produced by the parents or guardian who shall remain present in his behalf, along with the documentary evidence showing reason for the absence or inability to remain present personally.
- 16.4 After getting admission, the candidate shall, within a period of seven working days, report to his respective college or Institution. In case the candidate fails to get himself registered, within in the time limit the admission granted shall be treated as cancelled.
- 16.5 In the case, candidate fails to get himself/herself registered, within the time limit due to unavoidable circumstance, the candidate shall, after obtaining prior approval of the Committee or any officer authorised by the Committee within three days after the expiry of the time limit, produce documentary evidence showing reason for such failure. If the Admission Committee is satisfied, may grant him further period of not more than three days to report to the college or institution for the purpose of registration.
- 16.6 In case the candidate does not remain present for counselling for the purpose of admission at the scheduled date and time and approaches the committee on later date, with an application in writing, to allow him for admission he may be permitted for counselling and granted admission, in the college or institution and in the respective category available at such later date. He/she shall have no right to claim for the admission in the college or institution and in the respective category available on the scheduled date and time.
- 16.7 The fact that the candidate is called for counselling does not confirm the eligibility of the candidate.
- 16.8 The allotment of seats will be done subject to the merit position of a candidate and availability of seats in the category at the time of counselling. The allotment will be closed for that category as soon as all the seats in that category are filled up. The fact that a candidate has been called for counselling does not mean that the candidate is sure to be allotted a seat as the number of candidates for counselling will be more than the number of seats available.
- 16.9 The allotment of seats by the GCET Committee will be provisional. The final admission to the institute will be confirmed by the respective affiliating University after the candidate obtains a provisional eligibility certificate. However, the GCET Committee will not be responsible for rejection of the candidature of any applicant by the concerned University for any reason.
- 16.10 The seats will be allotted to only those candidates who satisfy the eligibility criteria and other conditions specified in the GCET-2008 Bulletin and who produce the required certificates/documents in original clearly fulfilling the requirements, and pay the requisite fee in Banker's Cheque/Demand Draft at the time of counselling.
- 16.11 The candidate belonging to reserved category may be allowed to remain present at the scheduled date and time of counselling for admission of the candidates of unreserved category, as per his/her merit number in the unreserved category. The admission shall be granted to such candidate in unreserved category, only if he/she is eligible to get admission, in the higher order of preference of courses than that in the reserved category.

- 16.12 In the case of reserved seats, the candidates should produce the required certificates/documents in original in support of their candidature. The caste certificates and other documents produced by the candidates will be scrutinised by the representatives of the concerned department of State Government and their decision regarding acceptability of the certificates/documents will be final and binding on the candidate.
- 16.13 The seats remaining vacant/unfilled after giving allotments to the respective reserved category candidates/after exhausting the list of eligible candidates of the concerned reserved category, will be offered to the general category candidates.
- 16.14 The updated details of availability of seats in each institute along with the code of the institution will be given at the time of counselling. The candidates are requested to familiarise themselves with the same so that they can exercise their choice without loss of time at the time of counselling.
- 16.15 Once the candidate exercises the option for the available institute, the same will be final and cannot be changed in favour of another institute.
- 16.16 The GCET -2008 Committee reserves the right to cancel any allotment of seat given/taken wrongly.
- 16.17 If, due to any administrative or other reason, the GCET-2008 Committee cancels the allotment of seat made to any candidate, the entire fee collected will be refunded.
- 16.18 On allotment of the seat, the candidate will have to deposit his/her original documents required for admission with the GCET Committee, which will be forwarded to the institution where the candidate has been allotted the seat, after the completion of the entire admission process. The candidates therefore, are advised to keep sufficient number of attested copies of their documents for their future requirements.
- 16.19 In the event of a candidate who is allotted a seat in an institute seeking cancellation of the allotment for any reason whatsoever, he/she will have to request for cancellation of the allotted seat in writing along with the fee receipt to the GCET Committee, with a copy to the respective institute prior to the reshuffling round. No request for cancellation of allotted seat will be considered by the GCET Committee after the reshuffling round starts.
- 16.20 No allotment of seat will be made without the required original documents. However, allotment may be made on the basis of results of the candidates conveyed through confidential letters by the concerned university/authority directly to the GCET Committee, Sardar Patel University. In case the candidate expects that the declaration of the graduation result by his/her university/authority is likely to be delayed, he/she should arrange for submission of the result confidentially by the university/Authority as stated above to the GCET Committee.
- 16.21 The candidate who is unable to submit original certificates and testimonies necessary for the purpose of admission at the time of counselling, may be granted provisional admission, subject to following conditions, namely:
- (i) On payment of Rs. 10,000/- as security deposit by the students. If the student submits the required documents within a period of ten days, the remaining amount of the security deposit shall, after deducting Rs. 500/- towards the administrative expenditure, be refunded.
 - (ii) In the event of failure to submit original certificates and testimonies within the time limit as aforesaid, the provisional admission may be cancelled and the security deposit may be forfeited,
 - (iii) The student shall not be required to pay the security deposit referred to in subclause (i) who has secured admission in other college or institution and submitted his original certificates and testimonies there, provided that the student produces the proof of having taken the admission in other college or

institution and submit the undertaking to the effect that he will get his admission cancelled in that other college or institute.

17 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED FOR COUNSELLING AND ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

The candidates or their authorized representatives should bring the following documents in original along with their attested photocopies:

- (a) Mark sheets of SSC (10th Standard), HSC (12th Standard) or equivalent examinations.
- (b) Final year mark sheet of graduation examination. First and Second year Graduation Mark sheets are also needed for verification.
- (c) The candidates who have applied against physically handicapped quota should bring a certificate issued by a Civil Surgeon, or a Resident medical Officer in the absence of Civil Surgeon, in the prescribed proforma.
- (d) The candidates who have applied against IN and EX-Service Defense Personnel quota should produce a certificate from the District Sainik Welfare Officer in the case of Ex-Service Defense Personnel and a certificate issued by an officer not below the rank of Commanding Officer in the case of IN Service Defense Personnel.
- (e) The candidates claiming reserved seats shall have to produce a certificate issued by a competent authority in support of their claim of belonging to a certain caste/tribe.
- (f) The SEBC candidates shall have to produce, along with the caste certificate, certificate of belonging to Non Creamy layer in favour of the family of the candidate issued by a competent authority on or after 1st April 2008. This should be in the form prescribed by the Government of Gujarat.
- (g) The SC, ST and SEBC (Including Widow and Orphan) candidates must bring original certificates obtained from competent authorities of Gujarat State.
- (h) All the candidates are required to ensure that they fulfill the necessary eligibility criteria mentioned in the GCET Bulletin 2008.
- (i) Every candidate who is allotted a seat in an institute will have to deposit the required fee immediately after the seat is offered, failing which the candidate will forfeit the seat and it will be offered to the next person on the merit list.
- (j) On the allotment of an admission-seat, the candidate has to pay fees as follows:
 1. Rs. 20,000/- per admitted candidate in private unaided institute
 2. Rs. 05,000/- per admitted boy-candidate in the grant-in-aid institute
 3. Rs. 01,000/- per admitted girl-candidate in the grant-in-aid institute.

19 RULES FOR RESHUFFLING ROUND TO FILL UP VACANT SEATS:

- 1 The Counselling and reshuffling/allotment against vacant/unfilled seats will be done at the Sardar Patel University, Vallabh Vidyanagar on the date specified in Important Date Schedule mentioned earlier.
2. The position of availability of vacant seats in different categories in various institutes will be displayed on the website: www.spuvvn.edu on the date specified in Important Date Schedule mentioned earlier.
- 3 Reshuffling and fresh allotments will be done strictly based on the merit position in respective categories.
- 4 **Candidates who are already allotted a seat** will be allowed to opt for available seats in those institutes which were closed and therefore not offered at the time of the first round of Counselling, based on their merit position. Such candidates will not be allowed to opt for institutes which were open and offered at the time of their earlier Counselling. (for the candidates who reported late during the earlier round of Counselling, their status will be calculated as per their scheduled reporting date/time during earlier Counselling and not the later date/time when allotment was done.) These candidates will have to bring their original fee receipts and should be willing to pay on the spot the fee difference, if any, applicable to the institute opted for.

- 5 **The candidates who are not allotted seats** for any reason whatsoever (including absent candidates and the candidates who were allotted a seat during earlier Counselling and subsequently cancelled their allotment), may take part in the reshuffling round and may be allotted seats. Such candidates will be offered only those institutions which would have been closed and therefore not offered, had they come and participated at the scheduled date and time during the earlier Counselling based on their merit. **Such candidates will not be offered a seat in any of the institutes which would have been offered, had they come and participated, at the scheduled date and time during the earlier Counselling** based on their merit.
